AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court with a prayer that despite they having been provisionally selected as Constables in Punjab Police and having completed all the formalities, appointment letter has not been issued to them.

It is the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners that when despite various visits to the office of Director General of Police, Punjab, appointment letter was not issued to them, a legal notice dated 04.02.2017 (Annexure P-7) was served upon the respondents but that also has not solicited any response till date. He states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 04.02.2017 within some specified time.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 04.02.2017 (Annexure P-7) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioners is not to be accepted a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to them forthwith.
