It is contended that the petitioner, who was working with Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited, was dismissed from service on account of registration of two FIRs. The first one was FIR No. 64 dated 06.07.2001 and the second one was FIR No. 55 dated 14.10.2001, both registered under Sections 406 and 120-B of the IPC.

It is contended that the petitioner has subsequently been acquitted in both the FIRs and has already requested for reinstatement by letter dated 13.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) which was subsequently followed by a legal notice dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-5). At the present moment, limited prayer is made that the respondents should be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner as set up in the said legal notice as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, the respondents are hereby directed to decide the claim of the petitioner as set

up in the legal notice dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
