The petitioner-Narbhinder Singh claims to have been engaged as a Home Guard and posted at Police Station Amloh in the year 1992 till 1994 when he is stated to have proceeded on leave. He was not allowed to join back on duty in the year 1994 itself.

Now by filing the present petition after 23 years, he is praying for a mandamus for allowing him to join back as Home Guard with all consequential benefits.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no case for any interference is made out for the reasons (i) that the details which have been furnished in the averments are vague (ii) that the claim is hopelessly barred by law of limitation.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
