Petitioner is aggrieved by notification dated 16.08.2016 issued by respondent No.1 granting approval for opening of Dhulkot Station for goods traffic and notified for handling of all commodities in covered wagons except PO with effect from 16.08.2016.

Apprehension of the petitioner is that in case the tender proceedings are not stopped for loading/unloading, it would result in traffic congestion.

In this context, the petitioner appears to have already submitted a detailed legal notice through his counsel to the General Manager, Food Corporation of India, Chandigarh, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-7.

Since it will not be feasible for this Court to enter into the disputed question of fact which might arise for determination of the averments mentioned in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition, at this stage, with a direction to the General Manager, Food Corporation of India, Chandigarh to consider legal notice Annexure P-7

dated 02.02.2017 and consider the averments therein and pass an appropriate order within a period of two months after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

It will be the duty of the petitioner to ensure that copy of the order along with copy of the writ petition is duly sent to the above said authority for seeking compliance of this order.

It will be appreciated in case after adjudication of the matter, the result is duly communicated to the petitioner, within reasonable time.
