The prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the letter dated 15.03.2017 (**Annexure P-3**) vide which the pension account of the petitioner has been attached whereby the recovery of alleged tax liability has been ordered against a protective assessment order dated 06.02.2017 (**Annexure P-2**).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently certain relevant material documents could not be appended along with the present writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action by appending all the necessary documents and making proper averments in that regard.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
