KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioners claim refixation of the pension and grant of pension on the basis of 5th Pay Commission Report in terms of Government Circulars dated 17.08.2009 and 22.02.2010 (Annexures P-9 to P-11). The petitioners also claim the benefits of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled as “**Karanvir Singh and others vs State of Punjab**”, decided on 30.09.2016. The petitioners have already issued a legal notice dated 09.01.2017 (Annexure P-15).

The short prayer of the petitioners at this stage is that the respondents may be directed to decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 09.01.2017 (Annexure P-15) by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 09.01.2017 (Annexure P-15) within two months from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is further directed that if any SLP has been filed against the order/judgment of *Karanvir Singh's case (supra)*, the legal notice of the petitioners will be decided within two months from the date of decision of the SLP.
