After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioner has also moved a legal notice dated 01.02.2017 (Annexure P-6) and at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
