Prayer in the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench (for short' the Tribunal); the order dated 19.01.2015 (Annexure P-5), whereby the resignation of the petitioner has been accepted and the order 10.12.2014 (Annexure A-4). Further a writ of *mandamus* has been sought directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in service considering service of the petitioner continuous and regular from 02.12.2014 till date and to pay entire dues including salary, increments and other emoluments arising therefrom along with the interest and as such grant promotion, seniority.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner

submits that in the order dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Tribunal, it has been noticed that verbally on 06.09.2016, his application for revocation of his resignation and reinstatement in service had been rejected, though he had not received any order in black and white.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Tribunal impugning the order passed in the application for revocation of his resignation and reinstatement in service.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
