The petitioner states that the respondents have not accepted his tender. The tenders were opened on 29.03.2017. The work is of labour and cartage and transportation of food grains. The petitioner has not even made any enquiries from the respondents in regard to his alleged disqualification. There is nothing on record to indicate that he has not been awarded the work because he was disqualified.

2. The petitioner must in the first instance at least seek a response from the respondents in writing.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to adopt proceedings after seeking a response from the respondents.
