Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that validity of Section 13 of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 is pending consideration before a larger Bench before Hon'ble the Supreme Court as referred to in Civil Appeal Diary No. 2365 of 2017, titled as Reliance General Insurance Co. Ltd. and anr. vs. M/s Mampee Timbers and Hardwares Pvt. Ltd. and another, decided on 10.02.2017.

Vide order dated 10.02.2017 passed in the aforesaid case liberty has been granted by Hon'ble the Supreme Court that concerned Commission can accept the written statement filed beyond the stipulated time of 45 days in an appropriate case, on suitable terms, including payment of costs and proceed with the matter.

In view of the aforesaid development, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail of appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.
