By this petitioner, the petitioner has claimed that as per notification dated 21.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) the State of Haryana had indicated that those retired doctors who had not attained the age of 64 years would be recalled to serve till they attain the age of 65.

The petitioner having retired in 2014 was about 60 years old and had moved an application (Annexure P-3) and notice (Annexure P-5) requesting the respondents to re-engage him in terms of the notification but till date no order has been passed. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.1 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to decide the above said notice (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order thereon

within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and, in case the petitioner is found entitled to the relief to re-engage him within such period.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
