KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner retired from service on 31.10.2012 as an Executive Officer on attaining the age of superannuation. His case for grant of benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme on completion of 4 and 9 years of service was sent to the Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab, on 30.5.2007, vide letter Annexure-P-2. It was again sent by various letters as mentioned in letter dated 13.2.2014 (Annexure-P-5), but the matter has not been decided so far. The petitioner has already made a representation dated 24.12.2012 (Annexure-P-3) to the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Samrala, but the matter is still pending before the Principal Secretary, Department of Local Government, Punjab.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the Principal Secretary, Department of Local Government, Punjab (respondent No. 1 herein) is directed to take a final decision on the case of the petitioner regarding grant of benefit of ACP Scheme on completion of

4 and 9 years of service, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
