The petitioner had applied for stage carriage permit vide application dated 02.03.2017, Annexure P-2. Legal notice to decide the said application has been issued just after eight days vide Annexure P-4 dated 10.03.2017. Hardly, one and a half month has passed and the petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to the State Transport Commissioner, Patiala to decide his legal notice dated 10.03.2017, Annexure P-4.

The petition appears to be pre-mature as the statutory authority requires at least period of two months to take any action under the statutory rules.

This petition is disposed of as pre-mature with an observation that if the claim of the petitioner is not considered by 30.06.2017, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again by moving appropriate application.
