The land of the petitioner was acquired by State of Haryana for Haryana Urban Development Authority and being an 'Oustee', his claim for allotment of a plot in the Oustees' category was considered in the draw of lots held on 28.04.2016, for which he had applied on 13.11.2011. The petitioner was successful in draw of lots but his grievance is that neither the allotment letter has been issued nor the authorities are inclined to issue the same at the rate which was applicable in the year 2011 when he had applied for allotment.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, there appears to be no justification for not issuing the allotment letter if the petitioner was successful in draw of lots. Similarly, rate of allotment also requires consideration at the hands of the authorities. Since the above-stated reliefs have been sought by the petitioner vide representations dated 29.01.2016 and 26.07.2016 (P-8 & P-9) followed by subsequent reminders (P-10 & P-11), we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to

months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
