KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioners claim re-fixation of the pension and grant of pension on the basis of 5th Pay Commission Report in terms of Government Circulars dated 17.08.2009 and 22.02.2010 (Annexures P-9 to P-11). The petitioners also claim the benefits of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled as ***“Karanvir Singh and others vs State of Punjab”***, decided on 30.09.2016. The petitioners have already issued a legal notice dated 22.10.2016 (Annexure P-15).

The short prayer of the petitioners at this stage is that the respondents may be directed to decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 22.10.2016 (Annexure P-15) by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 22.10.2016 (Annexure P-15) within two months from the date of

However, it is further directed that if any SLP has been filed against the order/judgment of *Karanvir Singh's case (supra)*, the legal notice of the petitioners will be decided within two months from the date of decision of the SLP.
