This appeal is against the award of the MACT case No.159 of 2013 dated 11.2.2015 passed by MACT, Gurgaon.

Vide order dated 2.11.2017 on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹ 5,80,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. However, today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has pointed out that there is some calculation error while calculating the compensation and the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹ 4,70,000/- and not by ₹ 5,80,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter-offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, ₹ 4,70,000/- (Rs.Four Lakh Seventy Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1-Sateshwari.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance

Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹ 4,70,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Sateshwari wd/o Sh. Deepak with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 25.01.2018 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
