The petitioners, who are working as Part Time Sweepers seek relief of regularisation from the date of their juniors have been regularised under instructions dated 11.11.2003 and 27.2.2004 (Annexures P/4 and P/5 respectively).

It is the case of the petitioners that private respondents no.6 and 7, namely, Bajrang and Sombir respectively who were appointed in 1998 and 2000 have been regularised. It is the further case of the petitioners that recommendation qua petitioner no.2-Rajesh Kumar for his regularisation was also made by respondent no.4 to respondent no.5 on account of the fact that juniors have been regularised.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that legal notice dated 25.8.2016 (Annexure P/10) has already been submitted to the respondents but the same has not been acted upon and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2 to decide the said legal notice within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Copies of the writ petition have been supplied to him.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case or legal right or entitlement as such of the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take into consideration the grievance raised in the said legal notice dated 25.8.2016 (Annexure P/10) and pass an appropriate order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent and copy thereof be supplied to the petitioners.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
