The petitioner challenges the order dated 07.09.2016 whereby the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench has turned down his claim for appointment on compassionate ground.

The father of the petitioner was working as Safai Wala since the year 1997 in the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Research and Education (for short, 'PGIMER'), Chandigarh. He unfortunately passed away on 27.08.2012 while in service. The mother of the petitioner applied on 14.09.2012 for appointment of her son on compassionate ground. The Committee constituted by the PGIMER in its meeting held on 29.11.2013 considered the petitioner's claim as per the prescribed criteria but unfortunately he could earn only 59 points as against the requirement of 65 points.

Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute that the petitioner has been duly considered strictly in accordance with the prescribed criteria. He, however, submits that subsequently the petitioner

however, fairly concedes that even if such additional marks are awarded, the petitioner is unable to reach the minimum bench mark of 65. In these circumstances, no case to interfere with the order under challenge is made out.

Dismissed.
