The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the proficiency step up has been granted to the petitioner yesterday only. Now, he restricts his claim to the release of the pensionary benefits. The petitioner retired from service on 31.3.2015. The petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 2.3.2017 (Annexure-P-8) upon respondents, but to no avail. The short prayer at this stage is to direct respondent No. 2 to decide the said legal notice dated 2.3.2017 (Annexure-P-8) in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 2.3.2017 (Annexure-P-8) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
