Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the counselling for admission in the post-graduate medical courses is to be held on today at 4.00 pm at the PGIMS, Rohtak. He has prayed that the petitioner may be considered for the grant of incentives to the extent of 10% for his each year rural service.

No doubt that on 16.05.2017, direction was issued to the respondents to give incentives to the petitioner to the extent of 10% for his each year rural service provisionally but learned Advocate General has apprised the Court that after the notification dated 05.05.2017 is quashed by this Court and upheld by the Supreme Court, the State Government has decided not to give any incentive to anybody across the State for the purpose of admission in the current year.

In view of the statement made by learned Advocate General, I do not find any reason to treat this case as a special case for the purpose of grant of incentives to the petitioner.

Consequently, the present writ petition is hereby dismissed being denuded of any merit.
