Challenge in this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing the impugned letter dated 17.04.2017 issued by respondent No. 3 (Annexure P-9) whereby the petitioner has been blacklisted.

2. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Ms. Jasjeet Kaur, from the office of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, states that petitioner is already continuing with the contract in pursuance to the interim order passed by this Court. However, the order impugned (Annexure P-9) blacklisting the petitioner on account of being unsuccessful in employing labour at chabal centre, shall be reviewed and in such circumstances, it was submitted that the same shall not be acted upon and is inoperative.

3. In view of the above, writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
