The petitioner applied for allotment of an industrial plot at Panipat under the category of 30 Crore Mega Project. The petitioner is said to have deposited Rs.26,00,150/- as earnest money on 15.07.2015. Its grievance in the instant writ petition is that neither plot has been allotted nor the amount is being refunded. The petitioner is running from pillar to post but except oral assurances, HUDA authorities have done nothing. The harassed petitioner served the respondents with a legal notice dated 15.02.2017 (P-7) for refund of the earnest money but its request to this effect has not been acceded to.

From the facts averred by the petitioner, *prima-facie* it appears that the HUDA authorities have not acted fairly with the petitioner. Suffice at this stage to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA to consider the petitioner's claim as contained in the aforementioned legal notice and dispose of the same by passing a reasoned order, within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
