The petitioner challenges the order dated 15.11.2016 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench whereby his Original Application questioning the order of reversion has been dismissed.

[2] The petitioner joined the respondent-department as Gramin Dak Sewak (GDS) on 01.01.1984. On the recommendations of the DPC held on 15.11.2013, he was promoted as Multi Task Staff (MTS) on 27.11.2013. He was later on issued a show-cause notice dated 12.10.2015 as to why he be not reverted to the cadre of GDS. The petitioner appears to have asked for some documents and it is claimed that due to non-supply thereof, he did not submit his reply. Thereafter, the impugned order dated 18.12.2015 was passed reverting him from the post of MTS and directing him to report on the post of GDS. The petitioner challenged the aforesaid order before the Central Administrative Tribunal. The official respondents in their reply-affidavit have explained that the petitioner was promoted as MTS in utter disregard to the claim of his seniors who are equally eligible. It was

explained that there are several eligible senior employees who were not considered at all. Names of some of those employees who are the complainants against the promotion of the petitioner, were duly disclosed.

[3] The petitioner could not refute the factual plea taken by the respondents, namely, that he secured promotion over and above his seniors who were denied the right of consideration unjustifiably. That being an admitted fact, reversion of the petitioner calls for no interference.

Dismissed.
