The petitioner's grievance is that as per the State Government Policy 08.07.2013 (P-1), 'first preference' was required to be given to Below Poverty Line families listed in the same town and followed by those listed in the same district for the purpose of allotment of EWS Houses but in the matter of allotment of such flats at Gurgaon, no preference has been given to the bonafide residents of Gurgaon district who are living below poverty line.

We cannot entertain such grievance for the reason that allottees of EWS flats at Gurgaon who are likely to be affected by the outcome of this writ petition, are not party-respondents.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner rightly submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to submit a comprehensive representation to the Competent Authority in the State Government.

Ordered accordingly.

If any such representation is made, the same shall be decided by way of a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of its submission.
