By this writ petition, the petitioner has claimed that he is entitled for permit for a light commercial vehicle.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in this regard, the petitioner has already got issued a legal notice dated 10.3.2017 (Annexure P-4) and that he would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to the respondent to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, the respondent is directed to decide the legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

This petition stand disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
