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**M.JEYAPPAUL, J.(ORAL)**

Both the parties along with their respective counsel were present. They suffered individual statements in second motion. They reiterated their original stand taken during first motion. They have submitted that there was no scope of them living together as husband and wife. We also find that the averments made in the joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act are true. A sum of ₹ 5 lacs deposited with the Registry in the shape of two bank drafts by party No.1 was also handed over to party No.2 today in the open Court. Both the parties have agreed to abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement. The criminal case launched by party No.2 against party No.1 was also quashed at the instance of party No.2. Accordingly, a decree of divorce by mutual consent as prayed for is granted and the marriage between the parties

is dissolved. Decree sheet be prepared.

Appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
