KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner claims that she is divorcee daughter of deceased-employee, who died on 15.08.2013. The mother of the petitioner also died on 29.09.2016. She claims that she is entitled to the family pension.

The petitioner has moved the representations. The last representation moved is of dated 04.03.2017 (Annexure P-7).

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to examine the claim of the petitioner and after hearing her and giving her opportunity to produce the documents, pass a speaking order as to whether on the evidence produced by her, she is entitled to family pension or not?

Let the petitioner along with the certified copy of this order appear before respondent No.2 and thereafter, a speaking order will be passed within three months from the said date.
