By this petition the petitioners are seeking direction to the respondent no.2 to implement the transfer policy-2016 in its true letter and spirit.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has moved a representation dated 12.05.2009 (Annexure P-4) and at this stage he would be satisfied if the direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
