The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to follow a uniform procedure of recruitment and allotment of seats to all the categories of posts of Sub-Inspector to District Police Cadre of Punjab Police under the Recruitment Test 2016.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh representation to the respondents regarding the grievance raised within a period of two weeks. He also requests that a direction may be issued to the respondents to decide the representation as expeditiously as possible.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, without going into the merits of the case, the respondents herein are directed that in case a representation is filed by the petitioner along with a certified copy of this order within a period of two weeks from today, the same be decided by passing a speaking order within a period of two months thereafter.
