Learned counsel appearing for the University has produced the result of the petitioner of Paper IV of Contract and Specific Relief Act of 5th Semester in which he had applied for re-evaluation. Unfortunately, the petitioner has failed in re-evaluation also and thus availed all the three chances as provided in Ordinance 6 of the Ordinances pertaining to Bachelor of Laws contained in Calendar 2008 Volume II of Guru Nanak Dev University and, therefore, the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the decision rendered in **Priansh Abrol v. Guru Nanak Dev University and others** decided on 04.05.2017 by which the similar controversy has been decided against the petitioner.

Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed. The result of the petitioner which has been produced by this Court after opening the sealed cover is returned back to the counsel for the University.
