The petitioner has questioned his non-selection to the post of Junior Engineer without there being any order. Further he has sought for writ of mandamus to consider his name for selection and appointment to the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical). In the absence of order or representation before the competent authority, writ petition is not maintainable.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.

Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach competent authority by giving representation or application in order to know how he is ineligible for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical). If such representation or application is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered by the competent authority by passing a speaking order and the same shall be communicated to the petitioner.
