KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner claims benefits of military service rendered by him during the time of 2nd National Emergency. He retired from service in the year 2009. He further claims that the legal notice dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) is pending before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.

The short prayer at this stage is that the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala may be directed to consider and decide his legal notice dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction of Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to consider the legal notice of the petitioner dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same by passing

a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, without being influenced by the fact that the petitioner has approached this Court.
