The petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to allow her to appear in the 6th semester exam of Contract-II and 8th semester exam of Family Law-II and Environment Law. The petitioner joined the Bachelor of Law(5 year integrated course) in the year 2010.

During the course of hearing, counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has to clear one paper of 6th semester, namely, Contract-II in which he had already availed three chances and one golden chance. She has prayed that the petitioner may be granted one another chance to appear in the said paper and in this regard, she has relied upon Rule 32 of the General Ordinance on Admission to Examinations provided in Guru Nanak Dev University Calendar, 2008 Volume II.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner and examined the available record.

Today, I have pronounced a judgment in CWP No. 8088 of 2017 titled as *Priansh Abrol vs. Guru Nanak Dev University and others* in which it has been held that the provisions of Calendar, Vol.II of 2008 are

general provisions which cannot be applied to the students of Bachelor of Law(5 years integrated course) or LLB of 3 years course as they have separate rules contained in Calendar Vol.III 2008 in which Rule 6 provides that three chances to be given for clearing the paper. Further Rule 9 of the said calendar Vol.II provides that degree has to completed after clearing all the 10 semesters. Counsel for the petitioner has failed to show any provision except for Rule 32 of the General Ordinance.

Hence, in view of the decision taken by this Court today in the case of *Priansh Abrol(supra)*, there is hardly any reason for this Court of interfere in this petition.

Dismissed.
