This petition is preferred by four petitioners who are students of LL.B(Five Years Integrated Course). Petitioner Nos. 1 and 3 had compartment in English Paper, petitioner No. 2 in Family Law paper and petitioner No. 4 in History paper of 4th semester in May, 2014. They took their chance in the year 2015 & 2016 respectively but could not clear the examinations. The petitioners have thus approached this Court, seeking a direction to the respondents to allow them to appear in the examinations which are scheduled to start from 5.05.2017.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioners can avail three chances and complete their course in seven years.

I have already taken a decision in CWP No. 8088 of 2017 titled as *Priansh Abrol vs. Guru Nanak Dev University and others* in which Rule 6 of the Calendar Vol.III 2008 Ordinances of Examinations pertaining to Bachelor of Law(5 years integrated course) and Rules 19 and 32 of Admission to Examinations containing in Calendar Vol.II 2008, general conditions have been discussed and it has been held that if students had

availed three chances in terms of Rules 6 of the Calendar Vol.III then he can not be given any other chance and, therefore, it can not be permitted to appear further because as per Rule 9 (ii)(iii) of the Rules contained in Calendar Vol.III 2008, the degree has to be obtained by clearing all the 10 semesters. Consequently, the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the decision of this Court rendered in *Priansh Abrol's case(supra)* and the same is hereby dismissed.
