The grievance of the petitioner herein is that despite being qualified he has not been offered appointment on the post of Motor Mechanic Instructor.

It is contended that in the year 2014, applications were invited to by the respondents to fill up the posts of Motor Mechanic Instructor in which three candidates sent applications to be considered for appointment and one Dharamjit Singh, who had the qualification of CTI in Carpenter, came to be appointed. Selection Committee, at that time, itself noted that this candidate does not fulfill the qualifications prescribed for the post of Motor Mechanic Instructor but still appointed Dharamjit Singh. It is contended that once again, the same person has been allowed to continue on the post despite the fact that the petitioner, having necessary qualifications, is available for the appointment. In this regard, the petitioner has already sent a representation (Annexure P-5) through registered post on 29.08.2016. However, the same is pending consideration. At the present moment, counsel for the petitioner prays for issuance of directions to the respondents

to decide the representation as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh representation before the respondents with a certified copy of this order within a period of two weeks. On receipt of the said representation, the respondents are directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of two months thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
