The petitioner herein was punished by order dated 07.08.2015 (*Annexure P-1*), passed by the Managing Director of the Punjab State Warehousing Corporation (*for short 'Corporation'*). Against the above referred punishment order, the petitioner has filed statutory appeal dated 04.05.2016 (*Annexure P-2*) which is pending consideration before respondent No.2- Appellate Authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that in terms of order passed by this Court in ***CWP No. 8013 of 2015*** titled as ***'Karanjit Singh and others versus The Punjab State Warehousing Corporation and another'*** decided on 05.05.2015, directions may be issued to the respondent No. 2- Appellate Authority to decide the appeal of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible and further that till the time, respondent No.2- Appellate Authority considers and decides the application for interim stay filed by the petitioner along with his appeal, interim stay may be granted qua the recovery ordered against the petitioner.

I have gone through the order passed by this Court in ***CWP No. 8013 of 2015*** titled as '***Karanjit Singh and others versus The Punjab State Warehousing Corporation and another***' and found that the case of the petitioner is fully covered by that order.

This Court is of the opinion that issuance of notice of motion in the present writ petition would unnecessarily delay the matter as the same can be disposed of at this stage.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Appellate Authority to dispose of the appeal filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible and in any case not later than six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is also directed that the Appellate Authority shall consider the application for interim stay filed by the petitioner along with his appeal and till the decision on the said application, no recovery shall be effected from him.

The writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
