The grievance of the petitioner, which is a private university created under Haryana Private University Act, 2006 is that for the first counselling held for admission to MDS and M.D. Courses, sufficient time was not granted, as a result of which the candidates from far off places could not reach for counselling and number of seats in the petitioner university remained vacant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that for the second counselling, no date has been fixed, as a result of which the candidates will not have sufficient time to attend the same and the seats may still go waste.

He referred to an interim order passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court

on 04.05.2017 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 244 of 2017, Education Promotion Society of India and ors. vs. UOI and ors. where certain directions have been given regarding admission to PG/MD/MS Diploma and MDS Courses for the session 2017-18.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Arti Singh, Assistant District Attorney, office of Medical Education and Research Department, submitted that second counselling has been scheduled for 11.05.2017 for which intimation shall be given to the petitioner and all other universities, private and deemed. Universities shall be given intimation regarding the schedule for second counselling by 2.00 PM today itself. The petitioner and other deemed/private university shall be permitted to issue advertisements for intimation to the candidates the schedule for second counselling. He further submitted that the authorities shall be bound by the interim directions given by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Education Promotion Society of India and others' case (supra).

In view of the aforesaid fair stand taken by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
