KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner served Army from 12.06.1963 to 24.02.1979 and thereafter, he joined the revenue department as a Patwari on 09.12.1987 under the Government of Punjab. He retired from service on 31.03.2001 on attaining the age of superannuation. The petitioner claims that as per Notification dated 01.07.2013, his service rendered during the 1st National Emergency i.e. from 26.10.1962 to 10.01.1968 is to be counted for grant of pensionary benefits. The petitioner has also made representation dated 10.03.2017 (Annexure P-5).

The short prayer of the petitioner at this stage is that the respondents may be directed to consider and decide his representation dated 10.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed to with a direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 10.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.
