Counsel for the respondents has produced the result of petitioner No.1 who has failed in Paper III Political Science I (Political Thought) of Ist Semester even after availing the extra chance under order of the Court. Otherwise, the petitioner had only three chances in terms of Ordinance 6 of the Ordinances pertaining to Bachelor of Laws contained in Calendar 2008 Volume II of Guru Nanak Dev University. Similarly, petitioner No.2 has also failed, as per his result produced today in Ist Semester in the fourth chance after availing three chances. Thus, the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the decision rendered in **Priansh** **Abrol v. Guru Nanak Dev University and others** decided on 04.05.2017.

Hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
