No sooner we were inclined to dismiss the writ petition on merits keeping in view the fact that the order passed by the Revisional Authority is just and fair on equity as well as in law, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the demand letter dated 07.02.2017 (P-6) asking the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs.1,56,40,346/- is totally cryptic, non-speaking and does not disclose as to how such amount has been calculated.

We have considered this submission and find somewhat merit therein. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the Estate Officer, HUDA, Karnal to furnish the statement of accounts as to how the above-stated amount has been determined. The petitioner, if so aggrieved, may submit his objections. However, in such an event, the petitioner shall be required to deposit the demanded amount without prejudice to his legal right to challenge such determination before the higher authorities.
