Reply by way of separate affidavits of Kuljit Singh, Assistant Inspector General of Police, NRI & Women Wing, Amritsar and Satpal Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, has been filed in court today.
