The petitioner has sought enforcement of the statutory obligation against respondent No.5 and sought a direction to lift/ remove the produce from the purchase centre at the cost of the buyer claiming that the produce is still lying at the Punjab Mandi Board Purchase Centre, Mamdot, Ferozepur. Photographs Annexure P6 have been placed on record in support of contention that there is breach of statutory obligation under Clause 11 (7) of the Punjab Market Committee Bye Laws.

In the reply filed, it has been submitted that stocks has already been lifted and the demurrage has been charged from the buyer and in view of said circumstances, this petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having rendered infructuous without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to seek any other relief/damages, if permitted under law.
