After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioners have also moved a Legal Notice dated 20.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) and at this stage they would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
