Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated persons filed CWP No.20174 of 2017 titled as Vijay Kumar & others Vs. State of Punjab & others before this Court and said petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice served upon the respondents and to take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In the present case also, the representation of the petitioner which is annexed as Annexure P-11 with the petition is pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the same directions are issued by this Court to consider the case as made out in the representation within some stipulated period.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 19.01.2017(Annexure P-11) and

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take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In case the petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief sought in the representation in view of judgment rendered in CWP No.25339 of 2015 titled as Sukhdhir Singh Sekhon & others Vs. State of Punjab & others, decided on 11.03.2016, the necessary relief be granted within a period of two months thereafter.
