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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner retired from service on 31.10.2016 on attaining the age of superannuation. It is claimed that some of the benefits have been released and some of the benefits have not been released so far. No chargesheet or inquiry is stated to be pending against the petitioner. The petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 7.12.2016 (Annexure-P-4) upon respondents, but to no avail. The short prayer made at this stage is to direct respondents to decide the said legal notice dated 7.12.2016 (Annexure-P-4) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the said legal notice of the petitioner dated 7.12.2016 (Annexure-P-4) and decide the same within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.
