The petitioner seeks quashing of the memo dated 20.12.2016 (P-4) vide which the HSIIDC has asked it to deposit principal amount of maintenance charges to the tune of Rs.1,32,430/- which was payable as per the Books of Accounts as on 31.03.2016.

The challenge is based upon a casual plea to the effect that the Municipal Corporation, Gurugram has already taken over the maintenance work, hence HSIIDC cannot recover the maintenance charges. The plea taken is totally baseless and not supported with any document. There is no notification whereunder the Municipal Corporation, Gurugram has taken the area for the purpose of maintenance. Nonetheless, it is claimed that the subject-area has been taken-over by the Municipal Corporation apparently on 30.04.2016. Assuming it to be correct, yet the maintenance charges levied prior thereto are liable to be paid to HSIIDC. The impugned memo clearly recites that the maintenance charges levied upon the petitioner are for the period before 31.03.2016.

No case to interfere with the impugned memo is made out.

Dismissed.
