The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned provisional merit list dated 25.09.2016 (Annexure P-3).

It is contended that the petitioner herein applied for appointment to the post of Constable pursuant to the advertisement issued on 31.05.2016. As per the petitioner, he, having qualified 10+2 and having the height of 5.10-½ Ft., would be entitled to a total of 27 marks which number of marks is the same as other candidates who have been brought on provisional merit list. Counsel for the petitioner urges that despite a representation having been filed for consideration for appointment on the said post, the said representation has not been decided. At the present moment, a prayer is made for directions to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner expeditiously.

In view of the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh representation before the

respondents with a certified copy of this order within a period of two weeks.
On receipt of the said representation along with a certified copy of this order, the respondents are directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of two months thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
