The petitioner has filed this petition for seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1/District Magistrate-cum-DC, Ludhiana to transfer case No.27/17 pending under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 [for short 'the Act'] before respondent No.2/Additional District Magistrate-cum-ADC, Khanna to himself and decide the same as early as possible.

After notice, it is submitted that respondent No.2/Additional District Magistrate-cum-ADC, Khanna, instead of initiating proceedings under Section 14 of the Act, has transferred the case on 12.5.2017 to the Debts Recovery Tribunal, which according to the petitioner is totally illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has thus prayed that the petitioner may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition in order to challenge the validity of the order dated 12.5.2017 passed by respondent No.2/Additional District Magistrate-cum-ADC, Khanna.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
