This is an application under Section 151 CPC for disposal of the main appeal in terms of compromise arrived at between the parties.

In view of above, the application is allowed and the main appeal is taken up today.

Main case

Learned counsel for the applicant-respondent No.3 submits that the Insurance Company is ready to honour the

proposal once made before the Lok Adalat and will deposit the amount of compensation before the Lok Adalat Branch in High Court within six weeks.

The amount shall be deposited in the name of appellant No.1 within the aforesaid stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the appellants has no objection to the aforesaid arrangement.

In view of above, the appeal is ordered to be disposed of with a liberty to the appellant to file an application in case the aforesaid arrangement is not complied with by respondent No.3.
