The petitioner is the aspirant of getting allotment of one of the parking lots of Chandigarh and for the same he had submitted Form V which has to be countersigned by the Municipal Corporation. Despite the fact that the petitioner had applied for the same almost 3 months ago no decision is being taken thereon.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to the respondent No.2 to take a final decision on counter-signature of Form V within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take a final decision on countersignature of Form V submitted by the petitioner, which is stated

to have been moved on 10.04.2017, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
